

## ANESTHESIA SIMULATION WITH FOUNDATIONS IN CPR

- Identify changes in physiologic parameters, potential anesthetic complications, their prevention and appropriate intraoperative interventions.
- Calculate and deliver fluid administration rates.
- Learn and practice proper BLS and ALS CPR practices in a simulated environment with two hour lectures and two simulated cases.
- Identify the different types of arrest and respond with breed- and species-specific techniques for dogs and cats.
