


Although most dental clinicians today are female, the cabinetry and storage they interact with was not designed for them.

Ergonomic Reach

When cabinetry is too tall or too deep, it can limit access to available storage and contribute to stress and strain injuries. Wall-hung cabinets with a lower upper height and thinner depth can improve access to storage with less reach and lean required.




Visibility
